

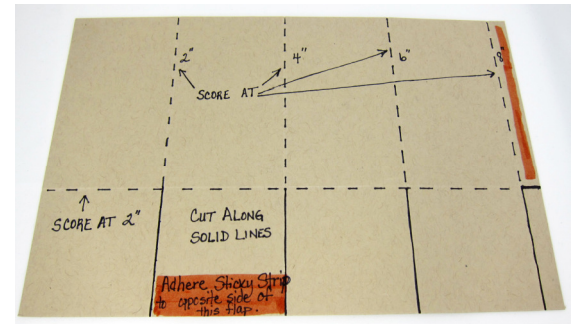
## 2-4-6-8 Oval Window Easter Box

### Cutting Dimensions:

Whisper White Card Stock	---	8 3/8" x 5 1/2" score @ 2", 4", 6", 8" turn & score @ 2"
Pink Pirouette Card Stock	---	6 1/2" x 2 3/4" (to punch scalloped ovals & tag)
Designer Series Paper	---	Scrap for Scalloped Ribbon Border Punch
Ribbon	---	3 1/4" x 1 3/4" (cut 4) + scrap for itty bitty flowers
Baker's Twine	---	8 1/2"

### Assembly Instructions: (It's helpful to read through all instructions before beginning.)

1. Position the 4 pieces of Designer Paper inside the scored sections of the box, leaving a border around each. Adhere to box with SNAIL Adhesive.
2. Punch 4 large ovals and one XL oval from the strip of Whisper White card stock. Create the scalloped window borders by positioning the Dotted Scallop Oval Punch over each of the 4 oval holes in the Whisper White card stock strip and punch a thin scallop frame. Set aside.
3. Use one of the punched large ovals as a guide for punching the windows into the box by adhering it to one end section of the box over the Designer Paper with a little SNAIL Adhesive. Be sure to position it closer to the 2" cross score line so the window is toward the lower edge of the finished box. Fold the punched section over the next section of the box and punch another window. Fold these two window sections of the box over the top of the remaining two sections and use the oval windows as a guide to punch the two remaining windows.
4. Apply 2-Way Glue around the edge of each of the punched windows and adhere the scalloped window borders.
5. Use the Paper Snips to cut along each of the score lines up to the 2" score line to form the bottom flaps for the box. Cut the 3/8" section out completely. (See template above)
6. Use bone folder to crease along each score line. Apply Sticky Strip to the outside edge of the 3/8" flap. Line up edges and adhere to assemble the side of the box.
7. To assemble the bottom of the box, fold the side flaps in first, then the back flap, then the front flap and adhere with Sticky Strip.

8. Use brush tip of the Pink Pirouette Marker to create a gingham design on the lower edge of the punched XL Oval. Stamp "Happy Easter" using Smoky Slate ink onto scrap of Whisper White card stock. Trim the stamped wording layer to create a strip and adhere to over the center of the Scalloped Ribbon Border with 2-Way Glue. Adhere to the tag with 2-Way Glue. Punch three Itty Bitty Flowers from scrap of Designer Paper so that the white polka dot is in the center. Adhere punched flowers to the top of the tag with Glue Dots.
9. Poke a hole through the top of the tag with the Paper-Piercing Tool. Thread the White Baker's Twine through the hole and make tie into a knot to create a loop to string onto the Chevron Ribbon.
10. Place a cellophane bag inside the box and fill with candy. Tie bag closed with Chevron Ribbon, then string the tag onto one of the the tails of the ribbon and tie ribbon into a knot. Trim ends.
