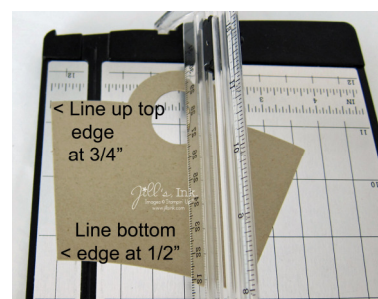
Cutting Dimensions:

Neutrals Patterns DSP	---	8" x 5 1/4"
Pink Pirouette Card Stock	---	2 Small Oval Punches, 1/4" Circle Punch
Whisper White Card Stock	---	1 3/4" Circle Punch, 1 3/8" Circle Punch, 2 - 1/2" Circle Punches, 3/4" Circle Punch, 2 - Large Oval Punches
Early Espresso Card Stock	---	2 - 1/4" Circle Punch
1/4" Grosgrain Ribbon	---	4"



Basket Assembly Instructions:

1. Die cut basket with Neutrals Patterns DSP using Baskets & Blooms Die.
2. Cut off the scored edge created by the die on both basket pieces.
3. Score along both side edges so that the top edge is at 3/4" and the bottom edge is at 1/2". (See picture) Do this for both basket pieces.
4. Score at 3/4" along bottom edge of basket pieces. (See template)
5. Fold along score lines (indicated by broken lines on template). Cut up to score line from bottom edge on both basket pieces to create flaps (along solid lines). Cut out flaps on one of the basket pieces.
6. Apply Sticky Strip as shown by red marks on template. The side shown is the right side of the DSP (polka dotted side).
7. Remove Sticky Strip backing along center of bottom edge of basket.
8. Center the two bottom edges and adhere together.
9. Remove Sticky Strip backing along sides and bottom flaps. Fold bottom flaps up toward the inside of the basket so they don't adhere before you have the sides lined up. Line up top side edges of basket and adhere the sides together. Use bone folder to stick bottom flaps to the inside bottom of basket.



Bunny Assembly Instructions:

1. Sponge edges of all White and Pink Pirouette pieces with Pink Pirouette ink.
2. Using Liquid Glue, attach eyes (1/4" Early Espresso Circles), mouth (1/4" Pink Pirouette circle), whiskers (1/2" White circles).
3. Draw whiskers onto 1/2" white circles with Early Espresso Marker. Highlight eyes with white gel pen.
4. Use Paper-Piercing Tool to punch hole for nose. Insert Pretty in Pink brad.
5. Layer pink ovals onto white ovals with Snail Adhesive, then attach to back side of bunny's head with glue dots.
6. Attach 1 3/4" Circle (bunny's body) to front of basket with Snail adhesive, leave enough room at the bottom for bunny's paws.
7. Attach bunny's head to body on the front of basket with dimensional.
8. Cut 3/4" white circle in half and draw paws with Early Espresso marker. Attach to lower edge of bunny's body with liquid glue.
9. Tie ribbon and adhere with glue dot, trim ends.
