Cutting Dimensions:

Naturals Ivory Card Stock --- 27/8" x 2" + scrap for oval punch

Linen Thread --- 10" Satin Ribbon --- 5"

Assembly Instructions: (It's helpful to read through all instructions before beginning.)

- 1. Lay the Muslin Bag flat onto the Stampin' Pierce Mat. Carefully ink the larger Bordering Blooms image with Early Espresso ink, making sure the ink is only on the image. Remove any excess ink from the block or photopolymer edges before stamping image onto bag. Press firmly. Repeat on the other side of bag if desired.
- 2. Ink the Bordering Blooms flower image with Tangelo Twist ink, the same as in step one, and stamp onto bag. Repeat on the other side of bag if desired.
- 3. Use the Scallop Tag Topper Punch to create tag from pre-cut Naturals Ivory card stock. Stamp Bordering Blooms images onto lower edge of tag using Soft Suede ink in place of the Early Espresso used on the bag. Sponge Soft Suede ink around edges of the tag.
- 4. Stamp sentiment onto scrap of Naturals Ivory card stock using Soft Suede ink and punch with Extra-Large Oval Punch. Sponge edges with Soft Suede ink. Adhere to tag with a Dimensional.
- 5. Thread Tangelo Twist Satin Ribbon through the hole in the tag and wrap around one of the strings on the bag. Tie Linen Thread around the Satin Ribbon into a bow. Trim ends on Linen Thread and Satin Ribbon.
- 6. Your bag is ready to fill and gift to someone.
