

Real Red Card Stock #102482

1 1/4" Scallop Circle Punch #127811  
1 3/8" Circle Punch #119860  
Small Oval Punch #120908  
3/4" Circle Punch #119873  
1/16" Circle Punch #101227  
Pear Pizzazz 1/2" Seam Binding Ribbon (retired)  
(can substitute 3/8" Lucky Limeade Ruffled Ribbon #122977  
or 1/8" Old Olive Taffeta Ribbon #119256)  
Linen Thread #104199  
3/16" Metallic Brads #119741  
Paper Snips #103579  
Simply Scored Scoring Tool #122334  
Stampin' Dimensionals #104430  
Glue Dots #103683  
Ruler & Pencil (non-Stampin' Up!)



## Cutting Dimensions:

Designer Paper	---	8 1/2" x 5 1/2" score @ 1 3/4", 3 1/2", 5", 6 3/4" along the 8 1/2" edge Turn and score at 1 1/2" & 4" along the 5 1/2" edge
Very Vanilla Card Stock	---	Scrap for stamping the tag
Real Red Card Stock	---	1 3/8" Circle
Ribbon	---	15"
Linen Thread	---	6"

## Assembly Instructions: (It's helpful to read through all instructions before beginning.)

1. Fold the two shorter (5 1/2") edges together so they meet. Hold the edges in place and punch through both layers with the Small Oval Punch to create the handle.
2. Fold along all score lines toward the center of box and crease with Bone Folder. Using Paper Snips, cut along flaps as indicated by solid lines on template.
3. Use a ruler to draw a light pencil line diagonally from the center flaps (box bottom) as shown in the template. Cut along pencil line with Paper Snips.
4. Cut 1/2" off the side flaps on one end of the box with Paper Snips (see template).
5. Attach a Glue Dot to the center of each of the remaining longer side flaps.
6. To assemble the box, begin by folding one center flap up first, then fold the shorter side flap up around the outside of the center flap, folding the short end flap to the inside of the box. Fold the longer side flap around these two flaps and fold the end of the flap with the glue dot to the inside of box and secure. One side of the box is now formed. Do the same for the other side of the box.
7. Insert the gift and tie ribbon through handles into a bow.
8. Stamp images with Early Espresso Ink and punch with the Scallop Circle and 3/4" Punches.
9. Layer punched elements together and attach to the Real Red Circle with Dimensionals.
10. Punch 1/16" Circle at the top of the tag and tie the tag onto the bow with Linen Thread.
