Cutting Dimensions:

Whisper White Card Stock	---	11" x 4 1/4" score @ 5 1/2" 3 3/16" x 1 15/16" Scraps (for stamping compass & arrow)
Midnight Muse Card Stock	---	3 3/8" x 2 1/8" 4" x 3/4"
Lucky Limeade Card Stock	---	1 3/8" Circle
In Color Designer Paper	---	3 5/8" x 3/4"
Sunshine & Sprinkles Designer Paper	---	3 5/8" x 3/4"

Assembly Instructions: (It's helpful to read through all instructions before beginning.)

1. Stamp sentiment onto Whisper White card stock (3 3/16" x 1 15/16") using Midnight Muse ink. Stamp sentiment again onto Whisper White scrap paper using Lucky Limeade ink.
2. Layer the Midnight Muse sentiment onto the Midnight Muse card stock (3 3/8" x 2 1/8") with SNAIL Adhesive.
3. Cut the Lucky Limeade arrow out with Paper Snips. Adhere over the Midnight Muse arrow with a Dimensional.
4. Stamp the compass onto Whisper White scrap paper in Midnight Muse ink and punch with the 1 1/4" Circle Punch.
5. Use the Paper-Piercing Tool to punch a hole in the center of the compass and insert a mini brad. Layer the compass onto the Lucky Limeade 1 3/8" Circle with SNAIL Adhesive.
6. Punch notches at both ends of all three 3/4" strips using the 1" Square Punch. Overlap and adhere the strips to the card front with SNAIL Adhesive.
7. Adhere the layered sentiment to the card front with Dimensionals.
8. Adhere the compass to the card front with a Dimensional.
